NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION

To the Duly Qualified Resident Voters of Galveston County Municipal Utility District No. 66, Galveston County, Texas and All Interested Persons:

Notice is hereby given that a bond election shall be held for Galveston County Municipal Utility District No. 66 ("District") between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on May 2, 2026, at county-wide polling places selected by Galveston County, which locations are declared to be public places for the purpose of this election.

The District has entered into a Contract for Election Services with Galveston County, Texas ("County"), under the terms of which the County will provide certain joint election services and equipment needed by the District in connection with the bond election.

The District has adopted the County's early voting and election day polling locations for the purposes of the bond election, which locations are declared to be public places for the purpose of this election. The election shall be conducted utilizing county-wide polling places pursuant to Section 43.007(a)(5) of the Texas Election Code, as amended; said county-wide polling locations to be selected and noticed to the general public by the County. Early voting by personal appearance will be conducted Monday, April 20, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, April 22, through Friday, April 24, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Saturday, April 25, 2026, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Sunday, April 26, 2026, from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., and Monday, April 27, through Tuesday, April 28, 2026, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.; at polling locations selected and noticed to the general public by the County. The main early voting polling location shall be located at Galveston County Records & Elections Center, 10000 Emmett F. Lowry Expressway, Suite 1152, Texas City, Texas 77591. A full list of polling locations can be found at www.galvestonvotes.org.

Voting in the election shall be on electronic ballots and HART Intercivic Verity DUO ePollbook equipment provided by the County. Ballots, voting instructions and the propositions will be in English and Spanish.

Applications for early ballots for voting by mail may be obtained from Dwight D. Sullivan, the Galveston County Clerk ("Early Voting Clerk"), at P.O. Box 17253, Galveston, Texas 77552-7253. The email address to which applications for early voting by mail and ballots to be voted by mail may be sent is absenteeballotapplications@co.galveston.tx.us. Applications for ballots by mail must be received no later than the close of business on April 20, 2026.

The following propositions shall be submitted at the May 2, 2026, election:

PROPOSITION A

THIS IS A TAX INCREASE

Shall the Board of Directors of Galveston County Municipal Utility District No. 66 of Galveston County, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said District in one or more issues or series in the maximum amount of \$24,900,000, maturing serially or otherwise in

such installments as are fixed by said Board over a period or periods not exceeding forty (40) years from their date or dates, bearing interest at any rate or rates and to sell said bonds at any price or prices, provided that the net effective interest rate on any issue or series of said bonds shall not exceed the maximum legal limit in effect at the time of issuance of each such issue or series, all as may be determined by the Board of Directors of said District, for the purpose or purposes of repairing, improving, or extending a waterworks system, sanitary sewer system, and drainage and storm sewer system, and/or purchasing, constructing, acquiring, owning, and operating such system, including but not limited to, all additions to such system and all works, improvements, facilities, equipment, appliances, interest in property, and contract rights needed therefor and administrative facilities needed in connection therewith, and to provide for the payment of principal of and interest on such bonds by the levy and collection of a sufficient tax upon all taxable property within said District, all as authorized by the constitution and laws of the State of Texas; said bonds, if approved, to be in addition to the District's voted but unissued bonds authorized at the District's bond elections held November 7, 2006, and May 4, 2019?

PROPOSITION B

THIS IS A TAX INCREASE

Shall the Board of Directors of Galveston County Municipal Utility District No. 66, of Galveston County, Texas, be authorized to issue the bonds of said District in one or more issues or series in the maximum aggregate original principal amount of \$9,700,000 maturing serially or otherwise in such installments as are fixed by said board over a period or periods not exceeding forty (40) years from their date or dates, bearing interest at any rate or rates, and to sell said bonds at any price or prices, provided that the net effective interest rate on any issue or issues of said bonds shall not exceed the maximum legal limit in effect at the time of issuance of each issue of said bonds, all as may be determined by the Board of Directors of said District, for the purpose or purposes of purchasing, constructing, acquiring, owning, operating, maintaining, repairing, improving or extending park and recreational facilities and amenities and all administrative facilities needed in connection therewith, including, but not limited to, all additions and expenses related thereto, all works, improvements, facilities, plants, equipment, appliances, interests in property and regional, regulatory or joint use participation rights or contract rights needed therefor, and for the purpose of refunding such bonds, and to provide for the payment of the principal of and interest on such bonds by the levy and collection annually of a sufficient tax upon all taxable property within said District, all as authorized by the constitution and laws of the State of Texas?
